



Clean Slate Volunteers

A Clean Slate team will consist of 5 team leaders. Each team leader is expected to recruit helpers for her area. Leaders and helpers will be focused on their area, but are asked to be flexible and willing to help the “team” as the job unfolds. The project will be completed over a 3 day time period, typically a Thursday night – Saturday. Team leaders must commit to the entire three days. The job descriptions are as follows.

Project Manager This is the point person for the project. She works closely with all members of the team to plan, budget, and carry out the vision.

Family Friend This is a spiritually sensitive person who will guide the family through the transformation. She is here to show the family support and encouragement throughout the entire process. This volunteer will make the initial contact with the family and is responsible for following up with the family after the Clean Slate project is completed.

Organizational Specialist This woman is involved in the initial consultation with the family and makes an evaluation of the overall needs to get the family organized. She would direct the family and team in day one of the transformation (minimization of clutter, and disposal of agreed upon items). She would recommend a budget for the family’s operation, organization, and storage needs.

Decorating Specialist This team member would be the designer in charge of decorating the space. She would be part of the initial consultation of the home and would work closely with the family and family friend. She would add special touches that would create a home reflective of family wishes and desires. She would also recommend a budget for materials, furnishings, and décor needed to complete the space.

Professional Shopper This team member would make purchases needed by the team to complete the space. She should know the ins and outs of Tulsa and have the talent of finding the perfect bargain. She needs to be able to work well with all team members and be a good manager of time and money.

Handy man We need some muscles on our team too. Our goal is to have at least one handy man to help with small carpentry projects for the home.

Extra Hands These volunteers have to be willing to work under a team leader to accomplish a variety of tasks such as sewing, painting and carpentry.
